



The National College Attainment Network is providing this information to make students and parents aware of why its important to complete the FAFSA application. The information provided on the FAFSA determines whether students are eligible for, among other types of aid, the Pell Grant —a federal, need-based award that does not need to be repaid. The high school class of 2021 left an estimated \$3.75 billion in Pell Grants on the table by not completing the FAFSA, according to an NCAN analysis. 


