

The National College Attainment Network is providing this information to make students and parents aware of why its important to complete the FAFSA application. The information provided on the FAFSA determines whether students are eligible for, among other types of aid, the Pell Grant –a federal, need-based award that does not need to be repaid. The high school class of 2021 left an estimated \$3.75 billion in Pell Grants on the table by not completing the FAFSA, according to an NCAN analysis. On June 26th through June 29th, we will launch our first **Moore Business Success Academy.** This three-day summer academy is geared towards students who are interested in pursuing a business degree at the University of South Carolina after graduation. Participants will experience what it's like to be a Moore School student by residing on campus, participating in engaging social and professional development activities, and will receive focused instruction in several core areas including: accounting, business analytics, economics, financial decision making, marketing, and business communications.
