



FAFSA® Application | Federal Student Aid | It is important for graduating seniors to complete the FAFSA application to seek and obtain future financial aid packages through their future college/career/technical school. (Check with the College or University you would like to attend.) School deadlines are usually early in the year, often in February or March, although some are even earlier.

When completing the FAFSA Application— Please remember.....

- Both you and your parent/guardian will need a FSA ID
- You will need your parents 2021 Tax Information
- You will need to complete the 2023-2024 application.

Other items to have available to complete the FAFSA Application......

- Personal Documentation Needed:
 - Student Social Security number
 - 2. Parent(s) Social Security numbers if you are a dependent student
 - 3. Student driver's license number, if applicable
 - 4. Student Alien Registration number, if not a U.S. Citizen
- Financial Information:
 - Your Social Security number (it is important that you enter it correctly on the FAFSA form)
 - 2. Your driver's license number if you have one
 - 3. Federal tax information or tax returns including IRS W-2 information, for you (and your spouse, if you are married), and for your parents if you are a dependent student:
 - a. IRS 1040
 - b. Foreign tax return, IRS 1040NR, or IRS 1040NR-EZ
 - 4. Records of your untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans noneducation benefits, for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student
 - 5. Information on cash; savings and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate (but not including the home in which you live); and business and farm assets for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student
