

COVID-19 Update: 3/13/20

Friday, March 13, 2020

As you are aware, on Thursday afternoon, the Governor declared all schools will be closed in Ohio beginning the end of the school day on Monday, March 16, 2020 through Friday, April 3, 2020. This closure will be reevaluated by the State prior to the end date and will be based upon the status of the spread of the Coronavirus.

Monday, March 16, 2020

All staff will report as a regular day on Monday, March 16, 2020 to plan instructional activities for our students. The buildings will be open from 8:00 AM until 3:00 PM on Monday, March 16, 2020. We are requesting parents and students to pick up all belongings. Parents may pick up student medication from the school nurse during these hours, as well.

Tuesday, March 17, 2020

Beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020, ALL buildings will be closed to the public and ALL district activities/events are postponed/canceled until further notice.

Assignments

It is Mapleton Local Schools' goal to continue educating your student with the intent to prevent loss of instructional time and your patience is appreciated with this transition. Assignment access notifications have been sent and additional directions will be posted on the district website. If Internet access is unavailable, these materials will be available for pick-up Monday. College Credit Plus (CCP) courses will follow guidelines as provided through the individual participating universities.

- Middle School will be available on Google Classroom or may be picked up at the school between 8 AM - 3 PM.
- High School will be emailed to the students' imountie account or may be picked up at the school between 8 AM - 3 PM.
- CCP students should continue to use their online platform.

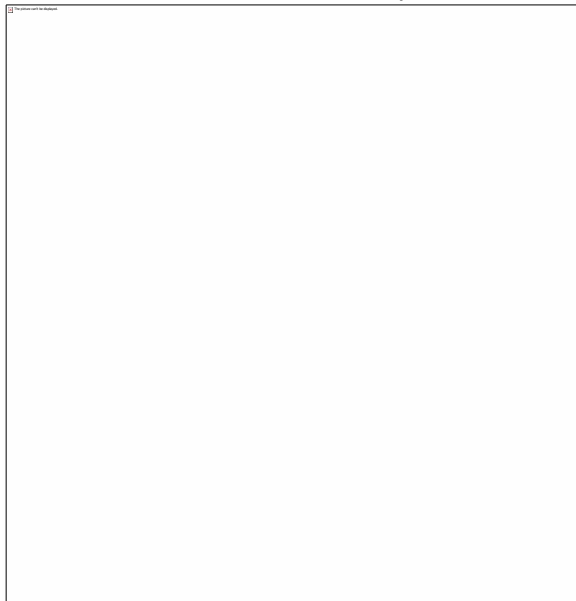
