June Finals/Regents Exams

The last day of regular classes is Friday, June 13th. We will conduct Final/Regent's exams from June 16, 2025 – June 25, 2025. There will be a modified schedule. Students will only report to school to take their exam and transportation will be provided for students.

There are morning sessions from 7:45-10:00 am and afternoon sessions from 11:45-2:00 pm. All students must stay until 10:00 am for morning sessions. Students taking regents exams may stay until 11:00 am. All students must stay until 2:00 pm for afternoon sessions. Students taking regents exams may stay until 3:00 pm and take the elementary bus home.




HOLLEY MS/HS VISUAL ARTS
