

Dear Hawk Families,

Holley Middle/High School will be conducting Midterm/Regents exams January 21, 2025 – January 24, 2025. During Midterm/Regents exams there will be a modified schedule. Students will only report to school to take their exam. Transportation will be provided for students.

There are morning sessions from 7:45-10:00 am and afternoon sessions from 11:45-2:00 pm. All students must stay until 10:00 am for morning sessions. Students taking regents exams may stay until 11:00 am. All students must stay until 2:00 pm for afternoon sessions. Students taking regents exams may stay until 3:00 pm and take the elementary bus home.

Morning transportation will arrive at the same time as regular school days. Transportation for students taking only PM exams will be communicated via the transportation office. If students have a morning and afternoon session on the same day, they will be provided lunch and supervised in between the two sessions. Students in grades 9-12 may leave after the morning session and return for the afternoon session. If students only have a morning session, they will receive breakfast, be dismissed at 10:00 am and transportation will be provided home. If students only have an afternoon session, transportation will be provided home. If students only have an afternoon session, transportation will be provided home.

All students must stay for the entire session. If a student needs more than two hours for a Regents exam, they can stay for up to three hours. Any student requiring more time will be dismissed on a case-by-case basis.
