The letter of interest must include:

- Name/Address
- A little bit about yourself
- Why you want to be a school board member
- What you think are the top issues facing the district

Candidates will be considered and possibly interviewed on June 17, 2024. The Board of Education plans to appoint the new members at their reorganizational meeting in July.

How Long is the Term?

A normal term is three years. Since this is due to a resignation, the board will appoint an individual to serve until the next regular election on May 20, 2025.

- Attend monthly BOE meetings and annual meeting
- Participate on district committees.
- Visible at district events such as athletics, fine arts.
- Review digital documents for meetings and or updates

What are the Qualifications?

In order to run for the Board of Education, a candidate must be:

- A U.S. Citizen
- a qualified voter of Holley Central School District;
- at least 18 years of age; and
- a legal resident of the District for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least 30 days.
