EdChoice Expansion Income Verification Process 2023 - 2024 Application Year:

The Scholarship office implemented an online process for Income Verification. The system is available for families to enter and submit their income information electronically to the scholarship office for verification of low income status. The secure income verification application will allow parents unlimited access to follow their income application status to completion. The system will automatically update parents via email when the income application review is complete or if a correction is needed. If you have not already set up an account, parents must create an OH|ID account to allow for secure access to the online application at: <https://ohid.ohio.gov/wps/portal/gov/ohid/login/>. Income Eligibility for the 2023 - 2024 EdChoice Expansion Scholarship:

All new first time EdChoice Expansion applicants must have a household gross income of 250% or lower of the federal poverty guidelines to be eligible for a scholarship, unless the applicant is eligible based on sibling criteria.

Please Note: Only scholarship families with a household gross income of 200% or lower qualify for low-income status. This means that the private school cannot charge these families for any tuition that is not covered by the scholarship. Scholarship families with a household gross income of 201% or higher are responsible for paying any tuition difference not covered by the scholarship.
