

2021-2022 OH PBIS Awards Application FAQ

Frequently Asked Questions

1	Q: The due date of May 1, 2022, falls on a Sunday and our building is closed on the weekends. I am wondering if we can turn the application in on May 2nd?	A: The due date will always be May 1st or the first workday thereafter. SSTs have flexibility as to how to address the due date should it fall on a weekend.
2	Q: Are buildings and districts allowed to carry over the award they received from the 2020-2021 school year?	A: No. Carry over for award levels was only allowable for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years because of Covid. This modification to the Ohio PBIS Recognition system has expired.
3	Q: How should I organize my district or building's evidence for review?	A: The Ohio PBIS Network has provided optional Evidence Binder Tabs for Tier I, II and III as a PDF within the Current Tools and Resources folder that can be utilized within a 3 ring binder. (Check with your SST if they request electronic submissions.)
4	Q: On the School Profile Template, if I am only applying for Bronze, do I have to complete the TFI for Tiers II and III? Same for Silver: do they have to submit a TFI score for Tier III?	A: Buildings and Districts must submit a TFI (including the walkthrough tool) for the following award levels: Bronze: TFI Tier I Silver: TFI Tier I & II Gold: TFI Tier I, II, & III
5	Q: Who will be "scoring" my application?	A: Each SST Region assigns who scores the applications using the

		OHPBIS Network approved Scoring Rubric.
6	Q: What if I disagree with the score? Is there an appeals process?	A: There is not a formal appeals process. This is handled within each SST Region .
7	Q : Does 70% ensure eligibility for recognition? What qualitative measures are being used to know that a school district/building qualifies?	A: Districts/Buildings/Programs should submit evidence to support the application. Just stating the TFI score of 70% is not enough evidence to secure the award level being applied for.
8	Q: How will the Student Profile Template Data and PBIS Report Card Measures impact my score this year?	A: The student profile template data and the PBIS Report Card Measures information is to be used for team reflection and future action planning and is not included in the scoring at this time.
