What is S.A.L.T.?

S.A.L.T. is a free monthly series developed to provide learning opportunities, along with resources and guidance, to help families of young adults with disabilities navigate through the transition from school to adult life and beyond.



What happens during a S.A.L.T. and S.A.L.T.-Teen session?



S.A.L.T. Session (Parents)

Presentations and guest speakers focus on a specific topic making it easy to understand for families or caregivers. This is a very supportive group who willingly listen to and share knowledge and information with each other.



S.A.L.T. – Teen Session (students age 14-22)

A fun and creative group that takes place at the same time as the parent SALT session. The teen session is geared towards fostering awareness of self-advocacy, independent living and employment.
