

Upper Arlington Summer Academy 2020 - COVID-19 UPDATE

Despite COVID-19, Upper Arlington School District will partner with the City of Upper Arlington Parks & Recreation Department to present the majority of its Summer Academy course offerings in a 100% ONLINE format.

Overview:

- In keeping with the District's mission, the Upper Arlington Board of Education is committed to providing a superior comprehensive summer school program for students and the Summer Academy plays an important role in living up to that mission.
 - By extending the school year, a large number of students are able to enrich, reinforce, or receive remediation in a variety of subjects and thus continue their education in a less traditional way.
 - Take a few moments and check out the following pages to see what we are offering this summer for students.
- **Registration:**
 - Online registration is available again this year through a partnership with the City of Upper Arlington @ <https://parks.uaoh.net>. **Online and in-person registration opens at 6am on March 11th, in person registrations are accepted at 3600 Tremont Road.**
 - Enrollment in all classes is limited and will be accepted in the order received. Please register according to the student's upcoming grade level in August 2020. Registration will close 3 days before the start of the class.
 - **Students will not be notified of acceptance in a course.** You will only be notified if the class is changed, full, or cancelled. Any classes that do not have a minimum of 6 students enrolled may be cancelled. Class cancellations will be communicated as soon as possible
 - **Attendance:**
 - Due to the abbreviated course design of Summer Academy, high school and middle school students taking credit courses and remediation courses are required to attend all **ZOOM live sessions** and complete the assignments in order to earn credit. Students enrolled must have access to reliable wifi/internet. Missing more than one **ZOOM live sessions** may prevent a student from earning credit.
 - **Refunds/Cancellations:**
 - A service fee of \$20 will be charged for all refunds except when a class is cancelled. Class cancellations due to low enrollment will be communicated as soon as possible and fees for those classes will be refunded in full.
 - All refund requests must be emailed to summeracademy@uaschools.org. There will be no refunding of fees after the first day of scheduled classes.
 - **Scholarships:**
 - Parents of students who need tuition assistance due to financial hardship must complete Form SAFA. This paperwork is available by emailing the Director at the email address below and must be completed prior to scheduling the Summer Academy class(es).

Course Offerings	COURSE DESCRIPTIONS
Improving Elementary Math Skills	Who said math in the summer can't be fun? Let's get interactive! This online class will reinforce the important math skills introduced during the school year through a variety of SeeSaw or Canvas lessons and assignments, utilizing some live Zoom sessions and some recorded sessions. We will be working on strengthening the understanding of numbers through mental math, number sense, creative problem solving, logical thinking, and more. This course is designed for the struggling math student or a child who needs additional reinforcement of basic skills.
Enriching Elementary Math Skills	Who said math in the summer can't be fun? This online class will enrich the important math skills introduced during the school year through virtual project-based learning utilizing either SeeSaw or Canvas, utilizing some live Zoom sessions and some recorded sessions. We will be working on strengthening the understanding of numbers through mental math, number sense, creative problem solving, logical thinking and more. Students will use manipulatives, build math vocabulary, and tackle out-of-the box problems, games and puzzles. This course is designed for the average or above average math student or a child who wants to expand their basic math skills.
Improving Elementary Reading Skills	This online course will use high-quality children's literature to support young readers in reading, writing, and word study. Through virtual lessons, students will explore a variety of types of literature through activities like read aloud, interactive reading and writing, and word decoding activities. Students will practice oral reading and comprehension skills as well as vocabulary enrichment and literary elements in a fun, playful, student-centered environment utilizing live Zoom sessions and some recorded sessions.
Enriching Reading Skills	This online course will use high-quality children's literature to maintain and extend young readers in reading, writing, and word study using a kid-friendly mix of interactive virtual lessons, utilizing some live Zoom sessions and some recorded sessions. Students will explore a variety of genres through activities like read aloud, interactive reading and writing, and word building activities. Students will work on enhancing their oral reading, comprehension, and writing about reading.
MATH CAMP	This is an ONLINE summer course for elementary students who will use their school-issued computers and the ALEKS program to build math skills. ALEKS is a web-based learning program that assesses what a student knows and does not know for each grade level, then builds a personalized learning plan based upon what the student is most ready to learn. This class is excellent for students who seek to strengthen and extend their previous years math knowledge. Students will work on their lessons, modules, chapters whenever they want throughout the day. Course Offerings	Course Descriptions
Middle School Math Credit Recovery	This course is a required course for middle school students who failed Middle School Math. The web-based learning called ALEKS will be utilized to build a personalized learning plan based upon what the student is most ready to learn. Online attendance may be required for the live sessions.
Middle School Language Arts Credit Recovery	This online course is designed for middle school students who need to strengthen and reinforce basic reading and writing skills and required for students who failed middle school language arts. Online attendance will be required during the live sessions.
Middle School Study Skills	CANCELLED _____ grades 6 - 8
Online Algebra I	This Algebra I ONLINE course is aligned to the Common Core standards and is available to any current CCM8 or CCM7/8 students who wish to take Geometry the next school year. The course focuses on both the content standards and mathematical practices. The critical areas of focus include: understanding properties of real numbers and exponents; applying and extending understanding of linear, quadratic, and exponential relationships in equations and inequalities; using function models to analyze data and applied situations. All students must register no later than 5/29 in order to be registered for the online program with a start date of 6/1. The end date (7/24) for this course is firm and all assessments must be complete by this date in order to earn credit.
Math Camp	This is an ONLINE summer course for middle school students who will use their school-issued computers and the ALEKS program to build math skills. 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High School Offerings for CREDIT/ENRICHMENT

Course Offerings	Course Descriptions
<p>PE I</p> <p>PEII</p>	<p>This course promotes individual physical fitness and well-being of students by providing lifelong physical fitness activities and skills designed to promote a healthy lifestyle. As this is an online course, students will need to have reliable internet access. Students will be required to complete four hours of fitness related activities daily for 12 class sessions. Each daily class session will be four hours in length and will include a cardiovascular endurance activity, self care/recreational activity, muscular strength and endurance activity, and a writing assignment. Through this process the students will be recording their progress on a google site webpage and each day's activities will need to be shared with their teacher by 5:00 pm each of the 12 days. Each ONLINE PE course will be limited to the first 28 students who register.</p>
<p>Health</p>	<p>This course promotes individual well-being and fitness of students by examining the ability to access, evaluate, and use basic health information, services, and products. The assigned work will be a combination of projects, research and reflection and class participation in discussion. There will be 2 required Zoom meetings for 1 hour each week and Zoom optional office hours for 1 hour two times a week. Students enrolled must have access to reliable wifi/internet. All work will be done through the Canvas platform. Work will be provided on the Monday of each week and will be due on that Friday. Late work will be penalized unless prior arrangements have been made with the instructor. This ONLINE course will be limited to the first 35 students who register.</p>
<p>Public Speaking</p>	<p>The purpose of this ONLINE performance-based course is to improve communication skills, with an emphasis on speaking before groups of people. Students will give a variety of speeches, including informative and persuasive. Depending on the enrollment, these speeches may be given live during the Zoom class or prerecorded. This ONLINE course gives attention to listening, delivery, construction, and content. Online activities will also include group discussions and oral readings. The course will be a balanced blending of online learning where students are independently working through assignments/lessons 2 to 3 days a week, while engaging in live zoom sessions 2 to 3 days a week. Due to the abbreviated course design, students are required to attend all ZOOM live sessions and complete the assignments in order to earn credit. Students enrolled must have access to reliable wifi/internet. This course will be limited to the first 20 students who register.</p>
<p>Online Algebra I</p>	<p>This Algebra I ONLINE course is aligned to the Common Core standards and is available to any current CCM8 or CCM7/8 students who wish to take Geometry the next school year. The course focuses on both the content standards and mathematical practices. The critical areas of focus include: understanding properties of real numbers and exponents; applying and extending understanding of linear, quadratic, and exponential relationships in equations and inequalities; using function models to analyze data and applied situations. Course Offerings	Course Descriptions
*High School Algebra I Semester II Remediation	This ONLINE course is designed for those students who failed to earn credit for Algebra I during semester two. Due to the abbreviated course design, students are required to attend all ZOOM live sessions and complete the assignments in order to earn credit. Students enrolled must have access to reliable wifi/internet
*High School Algebra II Semester II Remediation	This ONLINE course is designed for those students who failed to earn credit for Advanced Algebra during semester two. Due to the abbreviated course design, students are required to attend all ZOOM live sessions and complete the assignments in order to earn credit. Students enrolled must have access to reliable wifi/internet
*High School Geometry Semester II Remediation	This ONLINE course is designed for those students who failed to earn credit for Geometry during semester two. Due to the abbreviated course design, students are required to attend all ZOOM live sessions and complete the assignments in order to earn credit. Students enrolled must have access to reliable wifi/internet
*Language Arts Remediation	This ONLINE course is designed for high school students who failed to earn credit for 9th grade FLC, 10th grade SLC, 11th grade LLC11 or 12th grade LLC12 during semester one, semester two or both. Students will work with the instructor to develop a schedule to complete the required work.
