Dear Brentwood Families,

The Brentwood Borough School District was notified today that one Elroy Elementary School student tested positive for COVID-19. After consultation with the Allegheny County Health Department it was determined that one staff member is required to quarantine. No student close contacts were identified. The ACHD does not recommend the closing of the district school buildings.

The box below lists the most common symptoms related to COVID-19. The most recent guidance from the CDC recommends testing for students displaying these symptoms. With the increase in the number of testing sites, the results of the tests are returning in 1-3 days which is also helping to stop the spread.
