The Brentwood Borough School District is delighted to offer minicamps for students entering kindergarten through twelfth grade again this summer. Please review the options and determine your family's interest.

- Registration opens today, Friday, May 27, 2022, and will close on Friday, June 4, 2022. The link will be located on the front page of the district website beginning today.
- Capacity limits will be in place for the summer minicamps. For a camp to run it must have a minimum of five (5) students registered. The maximum number of students in one camp will be fifteen (15). If more than fifteen (15) students register, then the instructor may choose to run a second session of the camp during a different week. You will be contacted directly if this occurs.
- Cleaning of the facilities will occur after the daily programs.
- The Kinder Camp program will be funded through Title I money. The remainder of the programs will be funded using grant ESSER money.

We truly hope that our families take full advantage of these programs. It is the intention of the Brentwood Borough School District to continue in-person learning five (5) days a week for the 2022-2023 school year following the traditional daily schedule for all grade levels.
