

### **Homeless Students/McKinney-Vento Homeless Act:**

Homeless children and youth who lack a fixed, regular and adequate night time residence may qualify for services. The McKinney-Vento Act which was established in 1987 and revised/amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 ensures that homeless children and youth have access to the same free and appropriate public education as other children. Children who are homeless may qualify for assistance with school supplies, school lunches, and transportation so they can remain in their school of origin.
