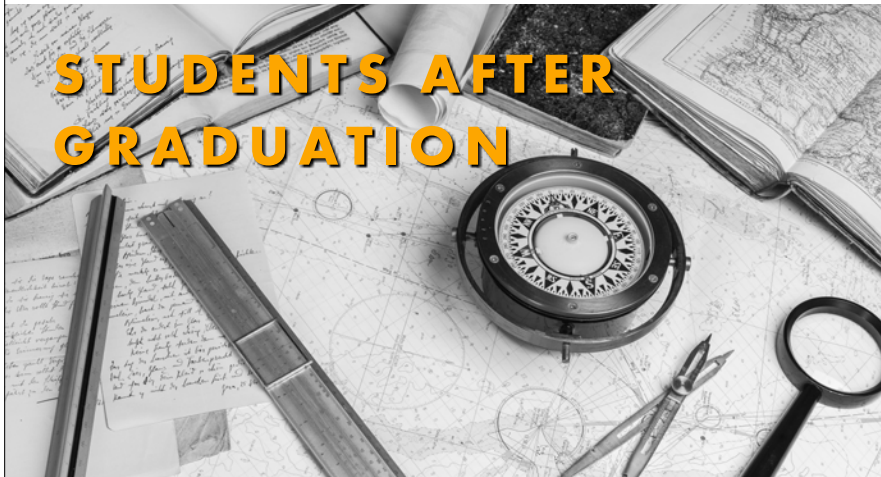
F1 IN SCHOOLS

- Brentwood is going to its third world championship this fall, having been selected as one of the top three schools in the nation.

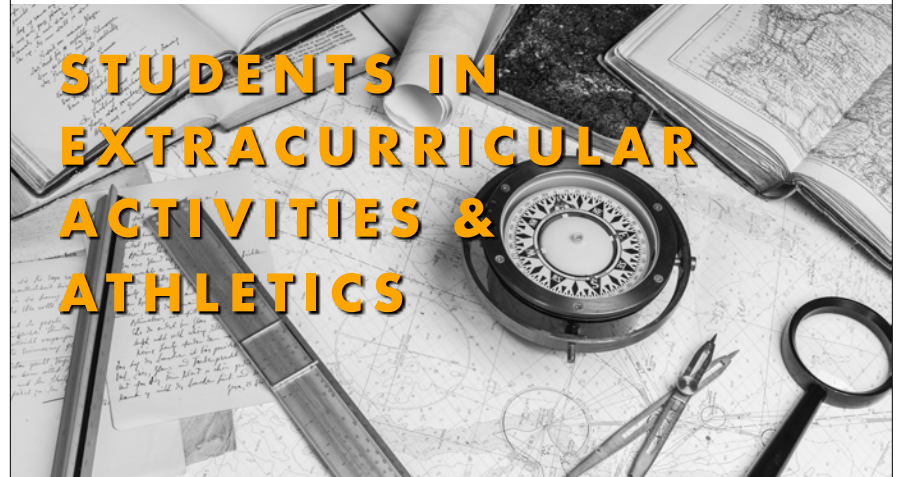

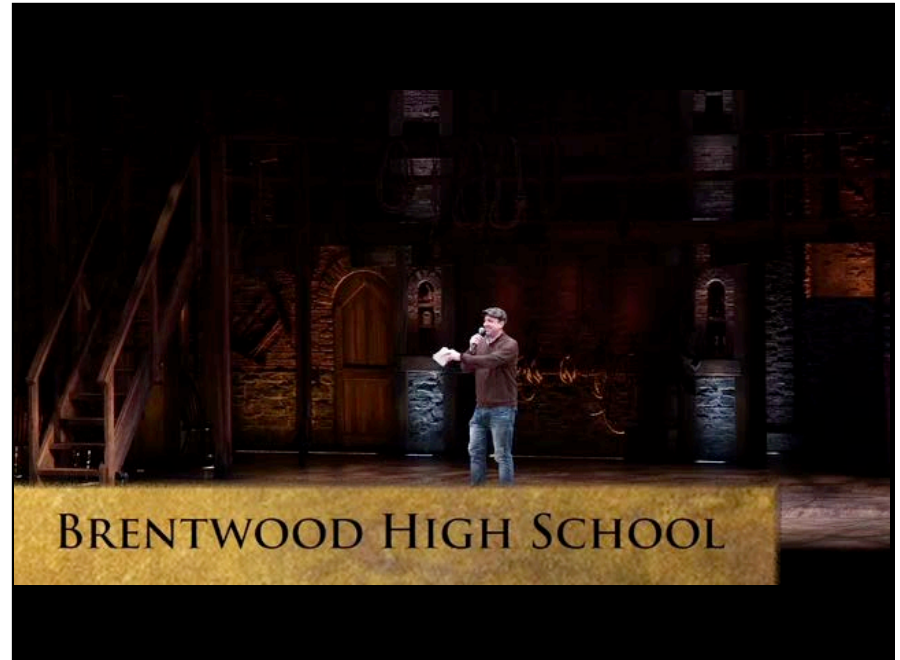

EMERGENCY PROJECTS

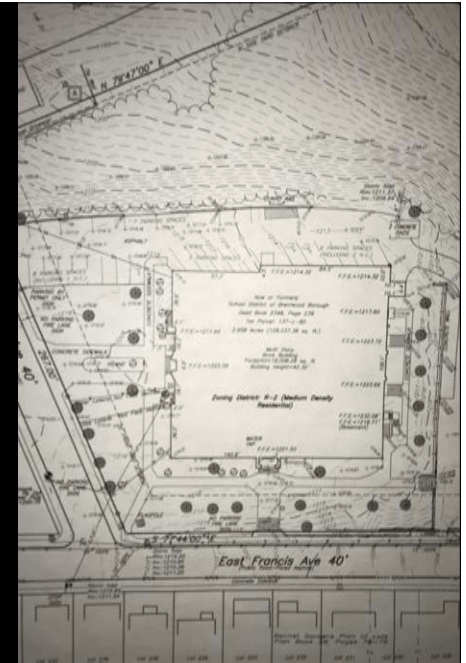
- Repair water damage from 2018 through insurance reimbursement
- Water infiltration @ Moore Elementary & Middle/High School
- Obsolete telephone system
- Move Middle/H.S. electrical entrance and fire alarm system





MOVING FORWARD

- Maintenance staff tackle projects within their schedule and skills.
- Complete bidding in fall when construction companies are planning their projects for the coming year for cost savings.
- Bundle smaller projects into larger annual projects for cost-effectiveness and better oversight
- Plan for future needs/projects



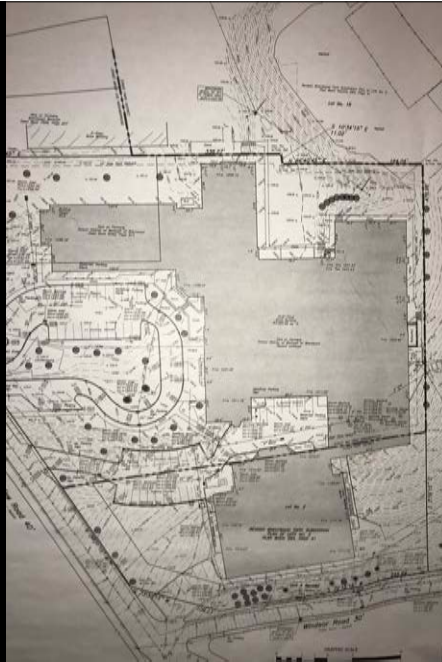

 - Gymnasium changes



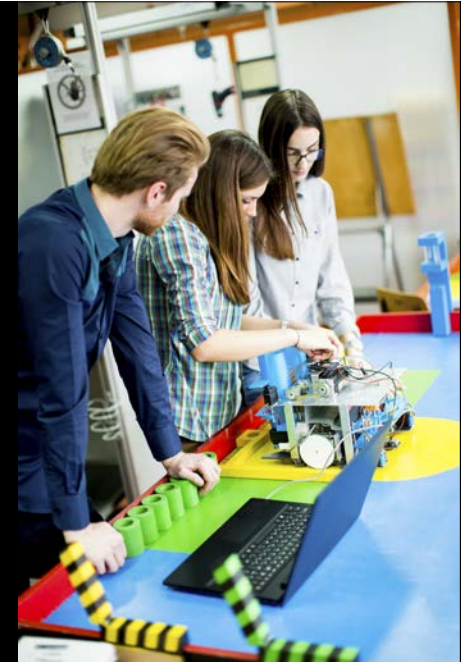

Moore roof, pointing, windows

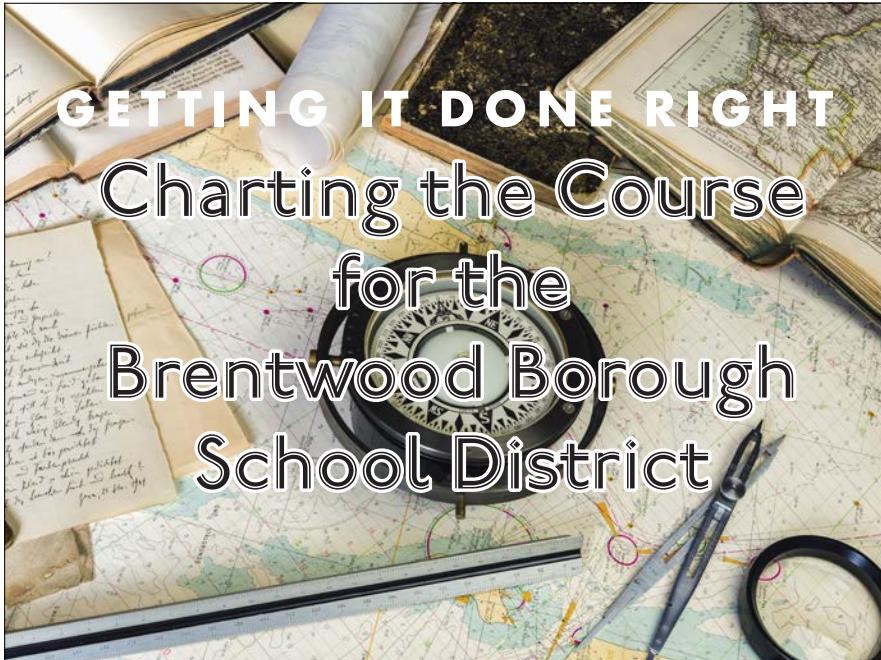


TIMELINE

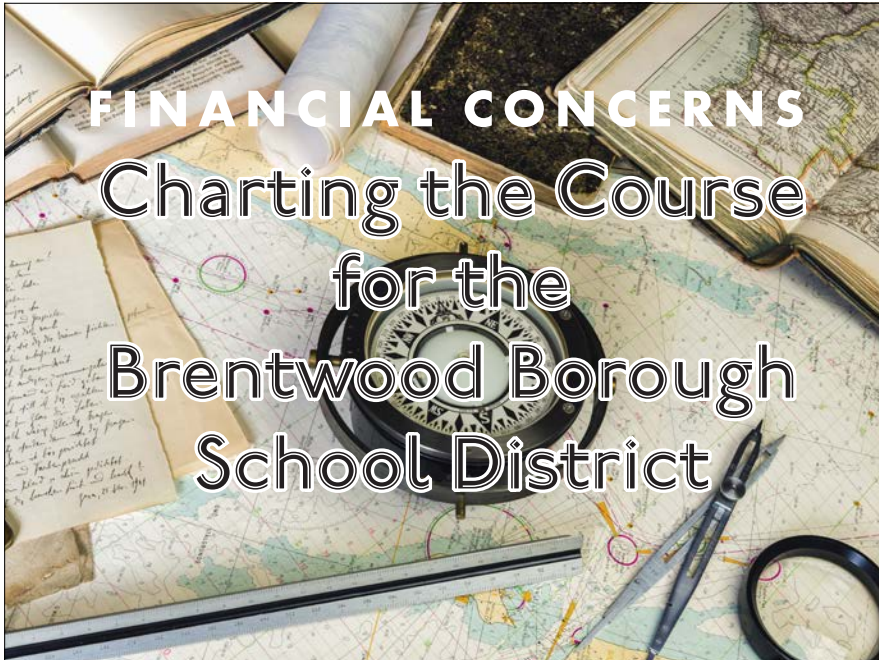
