## **2<sup>nd</sup> Nine Weeks Options Summary**

## **Elementary**

**Grades K-2-** Parents will have the option of returning their children to attend **in-person** four (4) days a week or attending **online** five (5) days a week. Wednesdays will remain as an online day for all students. If students do not have access to a device, paper packets of work will be made available.

K-2 parents, please complete the survey that was released on Friday, October 23. The survey will CLOSE on Wednesday, October 28 at 3pm. The transition will occur on Thursday, November 5, 2020.

**Grades 3-5**- Students will remain on a hybrid schedule of M/Th or T/Fr for in-person learning. The days when students are not in-person remain instructional days. If students do not have access to a device, paper packets will be sent home and are expected to be completed and returned on the next in-person day. Parents were individually contacted if their child received a progress report or are in jeopardy of failing a core course to schedule remediation time on Wednesdays. If you were contacted, please return the remediation form to the building principal. English as a Second Language (ESL) struggling academically will also be invited to work with the ESL teachers on Wednesday. The remediation classes will begin on Wednesday, October 28, 2020.

Requests to change from hybrid to online or online to hybrid, will still be taken at the midpoint of each nine weeks and the end of each nine weeks. Requests will be granted if at least three feet of physical distance can be maintained in the classroom.

In the cafeteria and the gym, six feet of physical distance will be maintained.

## **Secondary**

**Grades 6-12**- Students will remain on a hybrid schedule of M/Th or T/Fr. Wednesday remains an online day for all students. Parents are being contacted individually to schedule remediation time remotely with the teachers if their child received a progress report or is in jeopardy of failing a core course. In addition, beginning on Monday, November 9, remote students who would like to take advantage of in-person remediation and assistance will be able to meet with teachers at the school from 2:15-3:15 PM based on the schedule below:

MONDAY AFTERNOONS (2:15PM-3:15PM) – MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE, FINE ARTS, and ESL TUESDAY AFTERNOONS (2:15PM-3:15PM) – ENGLISH, SOCIAL STUDIES, FOREIGN LANGUAGE, and ESL

THURSDAY AFTERNOONS (2:15PM-3:15PM) – PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PRACTICAL ARTS, SPECIAL

EDUCATION, and ESL

Requests to change from hybrid to online or online to hybrid will still be taken at the midpoint of each nine weeks and the end of each nine weeks. Requests will be granted if at least three feet of physical distance can be maintained in the classrooms.

Students will continue to physically distance in the cafeteria during lunch periods.
