Dear Brentwood School District Parents/Guardians:

The purpose of this letter is to provide updated information regarding student hybrid or remote attendance at school.

Thursday, October 1, 2020 marks the halfway point (4.5 weeks) of the first nine-week grading period. As you are aware, families were informed that they may reconsider their original option of in-person or online learning every 4.5 weeks. The current rates of community spread continue to indicate that the hybrid model is the recommended course of action.

If your child is currently fully online and is having success, we ask that you consider continuing with that option. This will allow the District to continue following physical distancing recommendations with those students who are attending school in-person. As the number of in-person students increases, the physical distance provided between students in classrooms, cafeterias, hallways, and other areas of the building decreases.

If you would like to change your current status (either from in-person to online or from online to in-person), you must contact the office at your child's school **NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 25 AT 2:00 P.M.** After the information is collected, the families will be notified by district staff of any changes. If you plan to keep your child in their current status, no further action is required.

The District will continue to monitor statistics from Allegheny County and the PA Department of Education to make decisions regarding our ability to have students return to school in larger numbers.

The timeline for receiving the 1:1 devices remains the end of October. As soon as additional information is available, we will share it with families.

Our support staff, teachers and administrators continue to meet and discuss ways to assist our students. We would like to thank both our families and students for their support and cooperation so far this year, and we look forward to continuing to work with your children either in-person or online.
