Dear Brentwood Families,

The Brentwood Borough School District is delighted to offer a variety of educational summer programs for students entering kindergarten through twelfth grade. Please review the options as some are by invitation only, while others are open to grade level spans.

- A registration link will open on Wednesday, May 26, 2021 and will close on Wednesday, June 2, 2021. The link will be located on the front page of the district website beginning Wednesday morning.
- Due to COVID-19 restrictions, capacity limits must be in place for the summer mini-camps. For a camp to run it must have a minimum of five (5) students registered. The maximum number of students in one camp will be fifteen (15). If more than fifteen (15) students register, then the instructor may choose to run a second session of the camp either later in the day or during a different week. You will be contacted directly if this occurs.
- Cleaning of the facilities will occur after the daily programs.
- The Kinder Camp program will be funded through Title I money. The remainder of the programs will be funded using grant ESSER money.

We truly hope that our families take full advantage of these programs. It is the intention of the Brentwood Borough School District to return to in-person learning five (5) days a week for the 2021-2022 school year following the traditional daily schedule for all grade levels.
