HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR PHOTOS

OPTION 1: Schedule a local senior photographer and let them do it! (best option)

Camera Box is our unofficial official school photographer: You pick your proof for the yearbook, and they will be delivered directly to us. (No need to email Mrs. Gonce or confirm.) The sitting fee for Camera Box is \$30, which includes the portrait session and a photo for the yearbook. You are not required to purchase photos to get your formal portrait in the yearbook. <https://www.camerabox.com/patriots/>

Note: If you call after August 1st to make an appointment, you are already on the late side of scheduling. Camera Box will be offering "last chance" nights in September and October, which can be scheduled through Camera Box. These fill up quickly. If you look online, and the schedule is full, please call. They are very accommodating.

Angela Kauffman, Greg Starner, Nancy Zimmerman, and Fine Art also deliver portraits to us, and like Camera Box, they help us by sharing their amazing photography with the yearbook staff. You are not required to go these photographers, but doing so guarantees delivery (yes, they know our deadlines). Doing so also supports our community businesses who support our school.

OPTION 2: Submit your photo through email:

- Please have the photo file saved LastName_FirstName ie. Smith_Molly.jpg
- Please title the email subject as follows: Student's Name: Senior Portrait (Molly Smith: Senior Portrait)
- Email the photo as an attachment to agonce@wssd.k12.pa.us
- Look for a reply from Mrs. Gonce to confirm.

OPTION 3: Submit your photo on a thumb drive:

- Please have the photo file saved LastName_FirstName (Smith_Molly.jpg)
- Please put the thumb drive in an envelope Senior Photo Attention: Alison Gonce



SENIOR PORTRAIT SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a formal headshot (shades of gray or blue background)
- Boy's Formal Shot: jacket, tie, shoulders up photo, no hats (Most photographers have jackets/ties to borrow)
- Girl's Formal Shot: drape/conservatively formal shoulder up photo (Photographers have the black drape)
- Gender Neutral Option: plain dark top (Looks fine.)
- Black & white photos or portraits with dark or colorful backgrounds will look different from the majority of senior portraits in the yearbook.
- Note: We do not use "school photos" in the senior portrait section of the yearbook.
