You can get no-cost, in-home internet for up to two months during the new coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak if you qualify for certain low-income internet programs or have a student living in your household. Here's a list of the internet providers offering limited, no-cost internet services during the outbreak. ***Note: the chart (list) below is available on the website above, so it wouldn't need to be in this document.**
