Good morning,

Last Friday, March 5, 2021, we released this <u>video</u>, sharing information about a special board meeting for the Tolles Board of Education along with previous letters reiterating that our goal was to bring students back on campus whenever we could.

Last night, at the Special Board Meeting, the Tolles Board of Education approved the recommendation to move to an All-In, Five Days a Week Model of Instruction beginning Monday, March 22, 2021. Please review the following information for more details.

When we decided to start our school year with the Blended 2 Learning Model, we promised to revisit a variety of data sets and information and make changes each grading period to bring more students onto our Career Campus if possible. Due to outside agencies and regulations we needed to meet, we have been unable to make decisions for change at marking periods. With new information that individuals can be closer than 6 feet apart with 6 feet being preferable and that where we are not 3-6 feet apart, we "must make every attempt to maximize the distance between all students and staff," per Madison County Public Health, we are able to return to campus.

Based on this new guidance and our <u>Decision Framework</u> for Instructional Delivery priorities, the following items continue to be the focus of our decision-making:

- > Balance health and wellness and the educational needs of students in their career-technical and academic courses
- Prioritize time for career-technical education on the Career Campus since hands-on learning is the primary mode required
- > Provide additional modes of support for students when remote instruction is in place

Our <u>Decision Framework</u> also takes into account the needs of students, parents, and teachers in addition to health data from multiple health districts, local, state, and federal guidelines, the absenteeism rates of staff and students, and the instructional models of the seven (7) school districts we serve. At the writing of this letter:

- ➤ We have 1 confirmed case, 1 suspected case, and 2 contacts quarantined.
- > These are the lowest numbers we have experienced all year and many of our associate schools are seeing similar statistics.
- ➤ Community spread is stagnant or decreasing.
- > All 7 of our associate schools are scheduled to be ALL-IN by March 15th.

Lunch

> Students will be given their room assignments for lunch on the first day of orientation

> Spaces are designated for eating based on the distancing protocol outlined by MCPH

> All staff and students will eat in a 90min time frame, on three flights/periods (A, B, or C)

> Students will eat in one flight/period and will have two flights/periods for focused study



All Student Schedules

- ➤ School will operate from 8:16 to 2:50.
- > Class schedules will be given to students on their Orientation Day
 - Level I Orientation March 17
 - Level II Orientation March 18
- Students will spend ½ of the day in their CT Lab and ½ of the day in their Academic Courses. This will increase the CT hours for students and provide face-to-face instruction for academic classes required for graduation.
- Any student who has Study Center on their schedule for Period 4/5/6, which is now at the beginning of the day, is not required to report until 8:50 AM. Students must be in the building and ready to begin class at 8:50.

Half-Day Students

- Level One Half-Day Students will either ride the bus to school and have a study hall until 8:50 or may drive to school and arrive in time for their 8:50 class.
- > All districts that offer half-day options will provide transportation.

- The Tolles Career & Technical Center will continue in the Blended 2 Learning Model through Friday, March 12, 2021.

- ➤ Beginning Monday, April 5, 2021 Students on campus five days a week.
